On Tuesday, November 8, 2016, we held our monthly Board Meeting. This report describes the results of our meeting. The next meeting will be on Tuesday, January 10, 2017. We usually skip December as we have the Club Holiday Dinner scheduled for December 13 at The Beirut restaurant. Details on the Holiday Dinner were sent previously and a reminder will go out soon.

Here are the important items covered at this month's Board meeting:

Heralding the Holidays will take place on Friday December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2016, 4:00 to 9:00 pm, and Saturday December 3<sup>rd</sup>, from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. The Thursday morning painters have volunteered to set up on December 1, 2016. The Club still needs many volunteers to cover this event. We are restarting the Artists' Corner. For \$15.00 any member may display up to three pieces of art work in the Studio for up to three months. The artwork will be for sale with the Club receiving the usual 30% commission. We will be forwarding details on this in the very near future.

To draw more artists and potential members to our gallery shows, we will place a Call for Artists in the Blade (if they will accept it) at least two weeks before each gallery show (except the TWAL and People and Portraits shows).

We are raffling the Chris Leeper painting of the Maumee Theater that he donated to the Club earlier this year. Raffle tickets will cost \$20 each and will go on sale starting at Heraldng the Holidays. Members can pick up tickets at the club to sell starting on December 6. We will continue selling tickets until the drawing for the painting, which will take place at the Auction on March 25, 2017. More on the Raffle to come later.

A discussion was held about extending Take-in times for gallery shows to 6 pm. However, due to the difficulty of getting volunteers, the board decided to postpone any change until a later date.

Our next Members' Meeting will occur in January or February; once we pick a date members will be notified.
