Juror's Comments

It has been an honor to serve as juror for the 2013 Toledo Artists' Club Holiday Show. What a talented group of dedicated artists! I wish I had at least twenty awards to give out instead of just ten. In addition to the keen competition, judging was even more of a challenge because the themes and mediums were so diverse. I based my assessment on levels of skill, artistic expression, color and compositional strength.

In the spirit of celebration, I would like to share some of the wonderful qualities I observed in the pieces that I awarded top honors.

Best of Show went to Harold Roe for Trouble Bruin, because of incredible brushwork and strong composition. One can almost feel the fur on the bears and hear the sound of the waterfall. It is an exciting and accomplished painting of nature.

First place went to Virginia Kretz for Lathrop House because of the brilliant use of beautiful strong color that just knocked me out. Each brush stroke placed a definite color vibrating next to another to great effect. The composition is strong and balanced.

Third place went to John Trumbull for Chicken Coops and Rabbit Hutch. This watercolor, with its bold strokes, bold use of line, broad washes, virtuoso brushwork and strong composition is fresh, exciting and confident.

Congratulations to all of the winners and thank you to every one who participated in the show. And for those who did not win, don't be discouraged. There were so many truly outstanding pieces in the show. Your same piece may very well win top honors in another competition!

A note from the hanging committee about artwork submitted for a show

Identifying tags attached to the back of the work should be attached with masking tape (blue painter's tape works well & does not damage the work). You may place a piece of clear plastic tape (packaging tape) to the back of your picture and then tape your tag there. PLEASE do not staple or glue the tag to your piece. The hanging committee must move the tag to the front after jurying.

Please pick up your artwork promptly after a show closes. Storage facilities at the club are limited. **Artwork left more than 30 days after the closing of a show will not be retained by the club.**

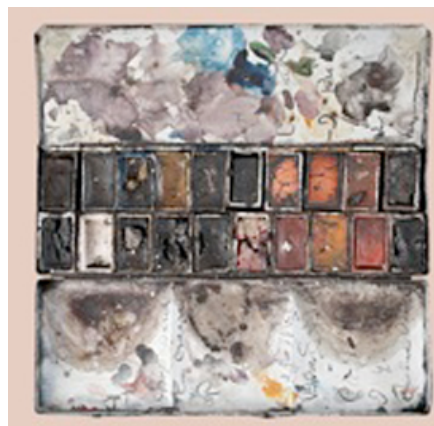

ELIGIBILITY: Toledo Artists` Club members and area artists.

All mediums: paintings, drawings, graphics, pastels, photos, three-D, ceramics, glass.

Entries can be images or items that represent any subject of the artist's choosing.

ENTRY FEE: **TAC members:** \$10 per entry, or 3 for \$25.00
No Refunds **Non-members:** \$15 per entry or 3 for \$40.00

ENTRIES: **Three (3)** works may be entered per individual. Attach official entry form (bottom of this prospectus) to upper left-hand corner on the back of framed work or the bottom of 3-D works.

ALL WORK MUST BE SUITABLY FRAMED UNDER ACRYLIC with wire, ready to hang. Do not use saw tooth bars).
Exceptions: pastels may be framed under glass; glazing is not required for canvas. Framing for canvas is required unless the sides of the canvas are part of the painting. Submissions must be original (no giclees, not copied, not done in a class or workshop). *Maximum framed size: 36" x 48". TAC reserves the right to refuse any subject deemed unsuitable.*

PICK-UP: Work not accepted can be picked up when the club is open. Accepted works can be picked up when the club is open after the show closes. **EXHIBITED WORK MUST REMAIN HANGING FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW UNLESS IT IS SOLD.**

SALES: **ALL WORK MUST BE FOR SALE** and **MUST HAVE A PRICE LISTED.**
All sales will be handled by the TAC, which retains a 30% commission.

Tape a label on the upper back left corner of each entry. PLEASE do not staple or glue the tag to your piece.
