A Report from the President

As many of you are aware, during the winter the roof was leaking in two areas, with water coming into the gallery. The botanical garden replaced the roofing tiles over the valleys on the north side of the roof at no cost to us, hopefully fixing the problem.

On a separate matter, during the summer the artists' club, as well as all the other resident organizations in the garden received letters informing them that rents would be greatly increased for the year starting in January 2015. The increases were based on assessments of the costs needed to repair the buildings, all of which are in poor condition. Two members of the Board of the Botanical Garden who have experience in construction carried out the assessments.

To review our lease Karen Ranney Wolkins, Executive Director of the garden, and Mike Parker of the botanical garden board, met with members of our board (Paul Brand, Cynthia Hoot, John Cook, Faye Edinger, Elaine Scarvelis, and Elaine Gregory) on Thursday August 14th. Karen and Mike emphasized that despite the proposed large rent increases, the garden wanted all the resident organizations to remain in the garden. Mr. Parker also said that the rent figures that had just been presented were based on an erroneous calculation and would be revised downward. For this reason we do not have a definite figure for the proposed increase for our club at this time.

We pointed out to Karen and Mike that the artists' club has an existing 10-year lease through July 31 2018 at an annual rent of \$450. Our attorney has again confirmed that our lease is valid. Consequently we do not need to be concerned in the near term with any increase in rent.

However, we need to prepare for increased expenses to maintain the clubhouse over the coming years. According to the terms of our lease, with regard to the artists' club, the garden is responsible for maintaining or repairing the roof and making any major external repairs. The club is responsible for minor external repairs and repairs inside the building, like the furnace, water heater and air conditioner as well as routine maintenance of the exterior and the interior. Since all of these units are old, we may have significant expenses to maintain them. Our board will be considering how to provide for future needs, and will keep you informed about proposed rent increases as information becomes available.
