June Artist of the Month Paul Sneider A lifetime resident of Toledo Ohio, Paul's initial experience with art started when he flunked finger-painting in kindergarten, and ended, when 8 years old, with an enrollment rejection from the Toledo Museum of Art's classes. He resumed his art career in March of 2013, at the age of 68 by taking classes with Teri Utz Bersee in Waterville, Ohio, and since then has been self-taught & persevering at all levels and media. Currently, he is enjoying painting with oils having worked with graphite, colored pencils, watercolor and pastels, but, has not gone back to finger-painting... yet. To use Bruce Watrol's words, "Paul has many pieces in private collections." After joining TAC in December of 2013, his Toledo Artists' Club awards have been:

ELIGIBILITY: Toledo Artists' Club members and area artists.

All mediums: paintings, drawings, graphics, pastels, photos, sculpture, three-D, ceramics, glass.

Entries can be any image of the artist's choosing.

Please consider donating \$5 to our fund to improve the lighting in the gallery.

ENTRY FEE: **TAC members:** \$10 per entry, or 3 for \$25.00 **Non-members:** \$15 per entry or 3 for \$40.00

ENTRIES: **Three (3)** works may be entered per individual. Attach official entry form (bottom of this prospectus) to upper left-hand corner on the back of framed work or the bottom of 3-D works.

ALL WORK MUST BE SUITABLY FRAMED UNDER ACRYLIC with wire, ready to hang (no sawtooth bars). Exceptions: pastels may be framed under glass; glazing is not required for canvas. Framing for canvas is required unless the sides of the canvas are part of the painting. Submissions must be original (no giclees, not copied, not done in a class or workshop). *Maximum framed size*: 36" x 48". *TAC reserves the right to refuse any subject deemed unsuitable*.

PICK-UP: Work not accepted can be picked up when the club is open. EXHIBITED WORK MUST REMAIN HANGING FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW UNLESS IT IS SOLD. Exhibited works must be picked up within 30

days of the show's end.

SALES: ALL WORK MUST BE FOR SALE and MUST HAVE A PRICE LISTED.

All sales will be handled by the TAC, which retains a 30% commission.

Tape a label on the upper back left corner of each entry. PLEASE do not staple or glue the tag to your piece.
