Juror's comments Any artist who wants to exhibit their work must accept that the awards represent one person's evaluation. I suspect that all judges begin with a set of expectations and personal preferences. It's important, then, to get past those biases by closely inspecting every piece, not just those that command attention at first. This was certainly the case with this show. How does one compare a difficult subject with a masterful technique or a unique point of view? In the end, I hope I have chosen not only all of these in selected works but also a sense of the artist's personal commitment to creating a piece that is more than the sum of its parts. There are so many accomplished works here. Certainly all are to be commended. Judging, while difficult, has been a great pleasure.

The Pink Dress (Albertie-Marguerite Carré, later Madame Ferdinand-Henri Himmes, 1854–1935)

Artist: Berthe Morisot (French, 1841–1895). 1870

Berthe Morisot's mother supported her daughter's ambitions by allowing her a serious art education. During the 1860s, Morisot developed a close professional relationship with Edouard Manet. She showed regularly in the Paris Salon and exhibited with the Société Anonyme des Artistes-Peintres, Sculpteurs, Graveurs — a landmark event that would become known as the first exhibition of the Impressionists. Morisot achieved significant critical

recognition during her lifetime, although 19th- and 20th-century critics focused on the “feminine” qualities of her work: intuitiveness, spontaneity, and delicacy. Her work was included in George Petit's International Exhibition in Paris as well as in Paul Durand-Ruel's exhibition of Impressionist painting in New York, both in 1887. Married to Eugène Manet (brother of Edouard Manet), Morisot had one daughter, Julie, whom she painted frequently and who provided the inspiration for her paintings documenting women's lives.

Theme Description: Anything American that pleases you: flags, buildings, fireworks, and yes, even apple pie!!

ENTRY FEE: **TAC members:** \$10 per entry, or 3 for \$25.00
No Refunds **Non-members:** \$15 per entry or 3 for \$40.00

ENTRIES: **Three (3)** works may be entered per individual. Attach official entry form (bottom of this prospectus) to the front or side of the piece with the blank side facing out or to the bottom of 3-D works so that the artist`s name is not visible. Tape should be Painter`s blue tape or equal.
TAC IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE TO ART WORK.

ALL WORK MUST BE SUITABLY FRAMED UNDER ACRYLIC with wire, ready to hang (no sawtooth bars).
Exceptions: pastels may be framed under glass; glazing is not required for canvas. Framing for canvas is required unless the sides of the canvas are part of the painting. Submissions must be original (no giclees, not copied, not done in a class or workshop). *Maximum framed size: 36" x 48". TAC reserves the right to refuse any subject deemed unsuitable.*

PICK-UP: Work not accepted can be picked up when the club is open. **EXHIBITED WORK MUST REMAIN HANGING FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW UNLESS IT IS SOLD.** Exhibited works must be picked up within 30 days of the show's end.

SALES: **ALL WORK MUST BE FOR SALE and MUST HAVE A PRICE LISTED.**
All sales will be handled by the TAC, which retains a 25% commission.

Tape a label on the upper back left corner of each entry. PLEASE do not staple or glue the tag to your piece.
