Liga Daiga – Sidecut Lock Sharon Lennard – Under Water Delights John Trumbull – Pacific Shore **Juror's Comments:** I would like to congratulate the artists who made submissions to the Water Wonderland Exhibit. As a selfprofessed 'Water Girl,' I am drawn to the theme; therefore the show was difficult for me to judge. There was so much to love here! Because of the large number of submissions, I was asked to eliminate works. Many of the pieces I rejected were due to presentation. As an art & framing professional, I do not see the frame as separate from the piece. It is where the art work lives and affects its look, longevity and value. Works with damaged or dirty frames were eliminated, as well as a few works that although good, were not as strong as the other works submitted. From there, I chose the winners. Tethered Voyagers was clearly # 1 in my view. The composition, color palette, artistry and scale made it stand out. Tom Sorrell's Hocking Hills showcases his mastery of the medium in a gentle, inviting painting. Sharon Lennard's Hidden was so well conceived and crafted, matching its name precisely with its seaweed tones and diminutive size. Dee Baker's Invitation to Fish appealed to me with its simplicity in theme and composition. As I write this, I see that I chose Sharon again for Honorable Mention, along with John Trumbull's Pacific Shore and

Liga Daiga's $Sidecut\ Lock$. Again \sim this was very difficult as the quality of these works are solid – I was glad to have chosen seven! Thank you for inviting me to judge.

Results of Annual Auction

Our members submitted 81 artworks for the auction, including 37 watercolors, 10 acrylics, 9 oils, 7 gouache, 6 pastels, 4 jewelry items, 3 photographs and 2 scratchboards (by Ernest Spring). Seventy-seven works sold along with 19 door prizes. Net income was \$3,465.10 from the club's share of sales plus admissions and the door prize raffle. This amount is about 10% less than last year due to lower sales prices on many worthy items. Well over 100 people attended.

ELIGIBILITY: Toledo Artists` Club members and area artists.

All mediums: paintings, drawings, graphics, pastels, photos, sculpture, three-D, ceramics, glass.

ENTRY FEE: **TAC members:** \$10 per entry, or 3 for \$25.00 **No Refunds Non-members:** \$15 per entry or 3 for \$40.00

ENTRIES: **Three (3)** works may be entered per individual. Attach official entry form (bottom of this prospectus) to upper left-hand corner on the back of framed work or the bottom of 3-D works.

ALL WORK MUST BE SUITABLY FRAMED UNDER ACRYLIC with wire, ready to hang (no sawtooth bars). Exceptions: pastels may be framed under glass; glazing is not required for canvas. Framing for canvas is required unless the sides of the canvas are part of the painting. Submissions must be original (no giclees, not copied, not done in a class or workshop). *Maximum framed size*: 36" x 48". *TAC reserves the right to refuse any subject deemed unsuitable*.

PICK-UP: Work not accepted can be picked up when the club is open. EXHIBITED WORK MUST REMAIN HANGING FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW UNLESS IT IS SOLD. Exhibited works must be picked up within 30

days of the show's end.

SALES: ALL WORK MUST BE FOR SALE and MUST HAVE A PRICE LISTED.

All sales will be handled by the TAC, which retains a 30% commission.

Tape a label on the upper back left corner of each entry. **PLEASE** do not staple or glue the tag to your piece.
